Dates for DDRs

Subsystem Mass

BMS relayed the message from Alcatel that the mass of the instrument declared in the IID-B was now over its allocation by ~9.5 kg and we are under pressure to keep this under control.

All subsystem providers are asked to review their mass budgets and provide revised estimates – including what margin is required given the maturity of the design - to Ken as soon as possible. This is with a view to reducing the declared margins on the mass of the instrument rather than reducing the actual mass at this time.

J-LA: The PSU specification will be completed by the end of July. No system level matters are outstanding but the specification will need approval from project as soon as possible.
