CEA Grenoble (Lionel) – Cooler

- STM Vibration test took place last week test was passed, but changes to the design were necessary the load on the cooler during the sine test at 40g caused slipping of the Kevlar in the pulley groove and the Kevlar got damaged (seen by a change in freq response after test). The cord was replaced and the cooler retested, and the same thing happened. The cord was replaced with the original, thicker, Kevlar and the test was passed OK. Apparently the thicker cord could be given a higher pretension, which meant the cooler was held tighter and could not slip during the test. Lionel will issue a report on impact on the cooler, but the cooler will remain in specification..
