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#### 1 - GENERAL DESCRIPTION

# 1.1 - SYNTHESIS OF OPERATING PRINCIPLES

The operating principle is that when in orbit around Mars , at switch on , or at weak-up , a number of parameters are given from module E to module O . In this way , after checking for communication , module O is ready for moving the pendulum, and take measurements. Before giving the start command, module E puts the scanner in the due direction. After the start , module O moves the double pendulum . This generates the laser diode radiation to produce the sine interferogram , which amplified, generates the zero crossing . The timing between the zero crossings is given to the speed controller . After some time the movement is stabilised. The zero crossing is also given to the sample and hold of the A/D converter. About 18 000 measurements are taken. When the Zero Optical Path Difference signal is obtained from the TRW device , PFS starts counting down to 8196. Module O selects 16384 data words around the ZOPD and gives the words to module E (SW) or extract 4096 words (one out of 4, LW) to give to Module E. Module E prepares these data for telemetry transmission.

We measure the radiation intensity coming from Mars and entering the Interferometer within the IFOV (4 deg for the LW channel , and 2 deg for the SW channel ). These measurements are repeated during the motion of the double pendulum, so that 18000 measurements are taken equally spaced in terms of optical path difference . Each measurement is taken every 150 nm of displacement of the corner cubes of the interferometer. These measurements are then reduced to 16384 for the SW and 4096 for the LW. The dynamical range of these measurements is tremendous as at least 16 bits are necessary to get the full information. The FFT of these measurements , which we can do on board in real time, will give us the spectrum of the Martian radiation in the wavenumber range 200-2000 for the LW and 2000-8200 for the SW. The spectral resolution is  $2\ cm\ 1$ , corresponding to more then 4000 for the ??? at  $8200\ cm\ 1$ , and corresponding to  $100\ at\ 50\ microns$ .

During cruise phase we will be using PFS mostly in the direct mode ( see the document science operations ) : example

Switch on Perform test 1 Stop test 1 Perform test 2 Stop test 2

Switch off

In orbit around Mars we shall make use of the cyclogram operations , and change the activity mostly by means of the Coded Control Table (  $commandsfrom\ E\ to\ O$  ):

At time t0-60 weak up, t0-50 start autotest, t0-45 start calibrations (10+10+10), t0-40 put scanner in due position , t0-39 start measurements ,... if mass memory full stop measurements and wait, t0+39 stop measurements , t0+40 start calibrations (10+10+10), t0+45 autotest , t0+50 go to sleep .

(\*) It is assumed here and in all the documents that will be possible to work for at least 53 minutes around pericenter, i.e. below 4000 Km altitude. Deep space and calibration black body measurements will be taken before and after this observation period, as they do not need the nadir pointing platform.

It should be noted that the number of Mbits per day that we want to transmit to ground are very flexible as we have possibility to reduce the amount of data by cutting either the interferograms or the spectra. The numbers given above shall be rather considered our baseline.

### 2 - INSTRUMENT CONFIGURATION

#### 2.1 – HIERARCHICAL CONFIGURATION

The general controller of the experiment is Module E. It has the most important part of the work : receives telecommands and act to serve them.

Can put the Module O and S in sleeping mode.

Gives to module O the Control table to be used, and gives the start for data acquisition. While Module O is taking new measurements , E can send data to FFT , if needed , gets the spectrum back , and prepares data for the spacecraft in the Data Telemetry Mode.

When needed Module E rotates the scanner to put it in the due position. The scanner position is reported back in the PFS status-housekeeping data.





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Module O after initial reset gives a word "99" to E for sincronization, then gives a ramp to check communication is OK. When requested gives the status data and the housekeeping of O. These are going to be part of the general housekeeping telemetry.

When order to block/unblock is received, O execute. When start measurements arrive , O execute. When data are ready O raises a flag and waits for E to accept the interrupt and start reading.

Module P it is switched on by the spacecraft, so automatically gives 5 V to E. Module E has the power to switch on the 15 V for O and for S.




Fig.1 – PFS general organisation



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#### 3 INSTRUMENT DETAILED DESCRIPTION

# 3.1 - THE ACQUISITION CYCLOGRAM.

We shall give here the detailed information on the cycle that provides one full measurement.

We start with the command from E to O to start a new measurement. O moves the double pendulum which goes in the so called "starting position". The motion of the pendulum starts and at each zero crossing of the laser diode interferogram of the SW channel the SW signal is sampled. At the same time the other laser diode gives another zero crossing for the sampling of the LW channel. While taking these measurements at a certain point the ZOPD zero optical path difference signals is received and a counter starts. When this counter reaches 8196, then the double pendulum is stopped. The number of measurements is simmetrized so that 16384 points are available for both channels. All this should be done in less than 5 sec. Data are then transferred to module E: for the SW all 16384 points are transferred, while for the LW there are 2 possibilities (depending of the mode requested) either all points are given or 4096 data points (one out of 4) are sent to module E. Here DAM receives the data, pass the data to ICM which performs the FFT for each set and then data are put in the mass memory. If interferograms are requested, ICM is ignored and data are put into the mass memory directely. From logic point of view only at this point DAM gives order to OBDM to start a new acquisition, but in reality the order has already been given after all data have been received from module O to Module E.

After each data acquisition cycle PFS checks whether new telecommands have been received and executes them (if any). The telemetry information can be sent at any time on request from the spacecraft.

Let us see here some details:

This cyclogram concerns OBDM and is about the acquisition of one interferogram for SW and one for LW. It implies also motion of the double pendulum and all the necessary actions to control the motion.

- 1 Start. Is a command from DAM to OBDM.
- 2 Start motion. Is a command/set up from OBDM to the analog electronics of the motor.
- 3 Check motion. It concerns 2 things:

Flag of the speed control loop up: speed locked.

Timer. Measure the time between two zero crossings and compares with a preloaded value. When the values are equal the motion is OK. possible failure mode here.

- 4 Acquisition. It is the routine reading the output of the AD converters (SW and LW). As the speed of the spectrometer is 2% different, the timing of the zero crossing may be different, therefore two different interrupts are needed. The two channels work independently. Each channel should also increment two counters: counter SW1 goes from 0 to 18000. Similarly for counter LW1.
- 5 Acquisition is stopped when one of the 2 counters LW1 or SW1 reaches the prefixed value 18 000 . (The failure mode should change this value to 10 000).

Counter SW2 and LW2 will increment up to the arrival of the zero optical path difference pulse , then will start decreasing. Note that these two counters could be the memory location itself, where the words are being written.FAILURE MODE HERE: IF THERE ARE DIFFICULTIES IN SPEED LOCKING, THE ZERO OPTICAL PATH DIFFERENCE MAY ARRIVE SOON, AFTER ONLY A FEW MEASUREMENTS ARE TAKEN. DECIDE IF TO GO TO ONE SIDED INTERFEROGRAM. The zero optical path difference is a pulse lasting 1 ms (4 readings), the rising part being the real indicator.





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- 6 Check motion. After the data acquisition is completed, the motion is checked again in order to give a quality flag to the data taken. This routine repeats action number 3 above. If motion not OK data re taken with negative flag, but everything goes as normal.
- 7 Stop motion. This routine allows to decrese the current in the motor and puts it in the stop (oscillating) condition. DAM is informed that the motor is being stopped.
- 8 Interferogram simmetrization. OBDM has taken 18000 measurements but only 16324 or 4098 must be trasmitted to DAM, and should be simmetric around the zero optical path difference signal.

Simmetrize the SW interferogram using SW2 information.

Simmetrize the LW interferogram using LW2 information.

Decrease LW info either by selecting 1 out of 4 or by averaging 4 measurements (telecommand).

#### THIS PART IS MADE BY DAM

- 9 Send Interferogram. OBDM sends both interferogram data to DAM according to a pre fixed procedure (hand shacking interferogram label).
- 10 Housekeeping. Here OBDM acquires the housekeeping data to be trasmitted to DAM to label the data just sent.

Temperature.

Voltages.

Laser diodes.

Motion quality.

etc. (see housekeeping info in the Telemetry and Telecommands DOC PFS).

Status.

- 11 Send Housekeeping. OBDM sends housekeeping info to DAM.
- 12 Status up date. OBDM receives from DAM the new status info (at least invert motion direction).
  - 13 New start. Goes back to number 1.



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#### 4 – INSTRUMENT OPERATIONS

#### 4.1 – NOMINAL OPERATION PLAN: THE DAM CYCLE.

This is the cyclogram of the acquisition of one set of spectra LW and SW as seen from the DAM point of view. Note that it is assumed that the switch on or the wake up procedure have been performed. Usually these procedures are followed by autotest. Here we assume that we are in a standard (baseline) acquisition phase, no difference being present if is calibration or actual martian data.

- 1 Scanner ready. Dam receives from the scanner controller the flag that scanner is looking in the direction in which we should take measurements. Dam receives also the scanner pointing direction.
- 2 New status to OBDM. This should contain at least inversion of motion, or anything concerning data acquisition or failure modes.
  - 3 Start. Command to OBDM to start a new interferogram acquisition.
- 4 COMPUTATIONS. This is a 4.5 5.5 s period in which OBDM acquires a new interferogram , and DAM uses for ICM interaction. DAM decides if an interferogram or a spectrum needs to be produced.
  - 5 Cleaning of LW interferogram.( this action needs to be defined)
  - 6 cleaning of SW interferogram.
  - 7 DMA transfer of LW interferogram to ICM.
  - 8 Receives LW spectrum from ICM.
  - 9 Receives LW Phase vector from ICM.
  - 10 DMA transfer of SW interferogram to ICM.
  - 11 Receives SW spectrum from ICM.
  - 12 Receives SW Phase vector from ICM.
  - 13 Cleaning of LW spectrum ( 2048 = >1300 )
  - 14 Cleaning of SW spectrum (8000=>6000).,
  - 15 4IF SCISSOR MODE 1to be applied cut SW (LW spectrum never is cutted).
  - 16 Prepare data with correct format and location and housekeeping.
  - 17 Transfer data to mass memory. Check if mass memory page is full, then switch. this part is performed only if interferograms should be transmitted.
  - 18 IF SCISSOR MODE FOR INTERFEROGRAMS is to be applied cut them.
  - 19 prepare data formats.
- 20 Transfer data to mass memory. Check if mass memory page is full, then switch. Check if mass memory is half full, then stop data acquisition ( Off line data compression should start according to the higher level cyclogram, see Mass memory cyclogram).
- 21 Get stop motor. Dam is informed by OBDM that acquisition is completed and that the motor is being stopped.
  - 22 Move scanner. DAM gives a new start to Scanner controller.
  - 23 Data acquisition. OBDM informs DAM that a new full interferogram is read to be sent. acquire label SW interferogram. acquire label LW interferogram.
  - 24 Housekeeping acquisition. DAM gets housekeeping and status info from OBDM. Wait scanner ready. The cycle starts again.

#### 4.2 - THE MASS MEMORY CYCLE.

This cyclogram coincides also with the so called downlink cyclogram , as now we have no data compression on board.

1 downlink. This is really an action of the satellite. But the result is TBD Mbit are again available.





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- 2 Uplink . The planning for the next four sessions is sent up to PFS . If nothing is sent, then the same planning will be used.
- 3 PFS is in sleeping mode: the next session of observation is prepared.
- 4 Wake up procedure starts when time is correct.
- 5 Autotest housekeeping.
- 6 Calibrations.
- 7 measurements. Repeat untill the 20 Mbit roughly mass memory is full.
- 8 autotest
- 9 request morion link and wait.
- 10 give packets data to spacecraft. If spacecraft manouvres are in program give to Module O order to block pendulum. NOTE THIS INFORMATION MUST BE AVAILABLE IN ADVANCE SO THAT A TELECOMMAND CAN BE SENT IN TIME SO THAT CAN BE ESECUTED AT THIS POINT . Clean mass memory.
- 11 go into sleeping mode.
- 12 wait for a new session.
- 13 the same as from point 3.

#### 5 MODES DESCRIPTION

#### 5.1 – SUMMARY

PFS has 5 operating modes: ASTRA , Sleeping , Autonomous test , Calibration , and Science mode.

#### 5.2 – MODES TRANSITION

ASTRA is an independent mode , which leaves the experiment really off, and is needed only for thermal heating of the experiment in case the experiment ( interferometer ) goes to too low temperatures.

Autonomous test, is a sequence of actions described below, which has the aim of studying the electrical, mechanical and optical status of the experiment.

Calibration mode, the experiment performs 10 measurements of the internal black body , of the internal lamp , and of the external deep space.

Science mode , it is the normal operating mode around pericenter : with the scanner in a fixed position ( Nadir) ,  $Module\ O$  takes continuously data and selects the interferogram which is then given to  $Module\ E$ .

Sleeping mode : after the data acquisition period around pericenter, and after a second calibration activity, PFS goes automatically in sleeping mode : only 5 V are on , and only Module E ( and P ) is powered. Telemetry to and from the spacecraft still works. The experiment will automatically switch on at the due time.

ASTRA requires High Power Command to be ON or OFF. All the other modes are automatically implemented in the Cyclogram activity.

#### 5.3 – MODES DESCRIPTION

#### 5.3.1- ASTRA MODE.

One or two days after launch, the ASTRA mode should be switched on. This mode allows the dissipation of some power inside the Interferometer block, so that the temperature shall not decrease in time, as it would be if no power is dissipated. Indeed the Interferometer block has the





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SW channel which works at low temperatures, therefore it is always connected to a passive radiator. During cruise phase the temperature could therefore go down very much if no heater is on. ASTRA provides 4 heating points inside IB , so that extreme low temperatures , which could permanently affect the interferometer, are avoided. In this mode PFS is off, only power is given to the ASTRA board.

#### 5.3.2 – The sleeping mode.

In orbit around Mars, when not operating, PFS will be in the so called sleeping mode . In this mode power is give to ASTRA and to Module E : Module O and the Scanner are off. This mode is used to keep data in the mass memory, waiting for the possibility to provide data to the spacecraft. In this mode , also, DAM may try the supercompression of the spectra, before giving data to the spacecraft. In this mode PFS may receive telecommands and the time information, so that may awake-up when the correct time is reached. The correct time is prescheduled in the orbit parameter computation.

#### 5.3.3 – The autonomous test.

This is the first activity after the awake-up command is received by DAM. The module O is switched on, and the autonomous test is started. In this mode we acquire information not only on the housekeeping of moduleO,E,P,S but also we move the double pendulum, we sample the laser diode interferogram, we control the speed control device by measuring for one full ramp the timing of the zero crossings, we test also the gains of the amplifiers, and other important quantities ( see description of the autonomous test in section below ).

#### 5.3.4 – THE CALIBRATION MODE.

Immediately after the autonomous test, PFS goes into the calibration mode, if the IB temperatures are OK. In this mode also the scanner moves, providing the possibility to acquire a number of measurements pointing first at the internal black body, then to deep space, then again to the black body. In each case a minimum of 10 measurements (20 measurements in the commissioning phase) are taken. These sequences must be done in time before the science section starts. But they are also repeated after the science section is finished.

As these two calibration sessions are repeated every orbit, they provide us with 60 measurements to be transmitted, to be added to the 480 martian spectra per orbit (at least).

#### 5.3.5 – THE SCIENCE MODE.

Along each orbit we will have a science session in which the science mode will be used for PFS . The operating period will in general last 80 minutes. In this period the scanner will be in a fixed position (probably nadir pointing) .

By operating 80 minutes , as the cycling acquisition time is of 10 sec max, we should get 480 measurements per orbit. If we are able to reach repetition time of 7.5 sec, then we can achieve more spectra per orbit. With an orbit of 6.5 hours we will have 1680 spectra per day. The possibility to transmit these measurements will depend on the capability to match the allocated data rate by means of data compression (FFT, spectral cutting or other).





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#### 5.4 - DATA ACQUISITION CYCLE.

We have given above the general information on the modes of operation of the experiment. We shall give here the detailed information on the cycle that provides one full measurement.

We start with the command from E to O to start a new measurement. O moves the double pendulum which goes in the so called "starting position". The motion of the pendulum starts and at each zero crossing of the laser diode interferogram of the SW channel the SW signal is sampled. At the same time the other laser diode gives another zero crossing for the sampling of the LW channel. While taking these measurements at a certain point the ZOPD zero optical path difference signals is received and a counter starts. When this counter reaches 8196, then the double pendulum is stopped. The number of measurements is simme trized so that 16384 points are available for both channels. All this should be done in less than 5 sec. Data are then transferred to module E: for the SW all 16384 points are transferred, while for the LW only 4096 data points (one out of 4) are sent to module E. Here DAM receives the data, pass the data to ICM which performs the FFT for each set and then data are put in the mass memory. If interferograms are requested, ICM is ignored and data are put into the mass memory directely. From logic point of view only at this point DAM gives order to OBDM to start a new acquisition, but in reality the order has already been given after all data have been received from module O to Module E.

After each data acquisition cycle PFS checks whether new telecommands have been received and executes them (if any). The telemetry information it is sent at any time on request from the spacecraft according to a FIFO procedure taking data from the mass memory sequence.

### 5.4- DATA TRANSMISSION MODES.

For every measurement PFS sends measurement conditions and data. The measurement conditions contain an angle of the Scanner position, a state of the module O during the acquisition, a data transmission mode and other parameters to be used for the correct interpretation of the scientific data. The data transmission mode defines the kind of scientific data PFS must select and store in the Mass Memory to be sent to the Earth.

THE DATA TRASMISSION MODES ARE OBTAINED WITH PFS OPERATING IN THE SCIENCE OPERATING MODE DESCRIBED LATER. ONLY DATA TRASMISSION MODE 0 IS OBTAINED IN THE PFS OPERATING MODE CALLED AUTONOMOUS TEST

For any science data transmission mode PFS acquires both LW and SW interferograms. If spectra are required, PFS makes Fast Fourier transform of the interferograms. Then, depending on the data transmission mode, PFS selects required data. Interferograms can be selected either completely or in half (the central part) giving reduced resolution. Modules (absolute values) of spectra can be selected in terms of spectral intervals (reduced range).





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There are defined 15 data transmission modes, some modes provide interferograms and some modes provide spectra (the numbering is inheritance of mars 96 project):

- MODE 0 It is a special mode of transmission of Autonomous test data . 20 Kwords
- MODE 2 full LW interferograms. 4096 MEASUREMENTS, 65 536 BITS. 4 Kwords
- MODE 4 reduced resolution interferograms (2048 points in the LW channel and 8192 in the SW channel). 163 840 BITS. Only the central part of the interferogram is transmitted neglecting the outer parts . 10 Kwords.
- MODE 5 reduced resolution LW interferograms. 32 768 BITS. 2 Kwords.
- MODE 6 reduced resolution SW interferograms. 131 072 BITS. 8 Kwords.
- MODE 7 In this mode the lw interferogram is transmitted complete, while the sw interferogram is cut in the following way: 2000 words around the zopd are identified, then the interferogram is completed only on right side. 13 Kwords = 26 K Bytes.= 208 000 bits.
- MODE 8 similar to mode 7 but for both channels on the right side: 12 Kwords = 24 K bytes.=192 000 bits.
- MODE 9 modules of LW and SW spectra (8192 spectral points in the SW channel and 2048 points in the LW channel).

NOTE THAT THE NUMBER OF BITS WOULD BE  $163\,840\,$  BITS, BUT THERE IS NO SPECTRAL INFORMATION IN THE FIRST 200 POINTS OF LW CHANNEL AND IN THE FIRST 2000 POINTS OF SW CHANNEL , THEREFORE WE HAVE  $6192+1848\,$  POINTS =  $128\,$ 640 BITS.

- MODE 10 modules of LW spectra. 29 568 bits per measurement.
- MODE 15 modules of SW spectra with reduced range, with the LW complete (2000 points in the LW channel and 2000 points in the SW channel). Total 4000 measurements , 64000 bits. This is the night sidemode.
- MODE 16 modules of SW spectra (6144 points), 98 304 bits.
- MODE 17 full interferograms (4096 points in the LW channel and 16384 points in the SW channel)
- MODE 18 full SW interferograms (and 16384 points in the SW channel)
- MODE 27 In this mode the lw interferogram is transmitted complete, while the sw interferogram is cut in the following way: 2000 words around the zopd are identified, then the interferogram is completed only on left side. 13 Kwords = 26 K Bytes. = 208 000 bits. the night sidemode.
- MODE 28 similar to mode 27 but for both channels on the left side: 12 Kwords = 24 K bytes.=192 000 bits.

#### 1- SWITCH ON

the SWICTH ON PROCEDURE regular is:

1 - Switch on is a HIGH POWER COMMAND . It gives power to module P and module E. A module P check out procedure starts at this point :

2 -Check the '5V ok' line. If not ok the experiment must be switched off.

There is no way we can test and correct directely on board. DAM should

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#### 5 CALIBRATION

( ALSO CALLED TEST 4)

In an orbit around Mars we shall use two times the calibration procedure. This is a sequence of data taking: the scanner is put first on deep space direction and N measurements are taken (in commissioning palse may be 13 or more, in normal conditions will be 10). Then the scanner is rotated in the Black Body direction and another N measurements are taken. Finally the scanner is rotated in the Cakibration Lamp direction and N measurements are taken. All this provides 3 N measurements to be transmitted always as interferograms. The number of measurements N is given by means of telecommand 102. It is possible to change the DTM mode for calibrations by using the proper telecommand.

#### 6.1 - AUTOTEST MODE.

The autotest procedure has the aim to test the status and the functioning of the interferometer . The autotest will also generate some data which shall be trasmitted and examined on ground. The data trasmitted will be in the same amount of a full interferogram for both LW and SW channel, but the content of the information will be different.

#### -- AUTOTEST OF MODULE O.

The autotest will be performed in at least 60 seconds, as it will request several full motions of the pendulum in one direction and back.

Motion 1

In the first motion the timing between successive zero crossings will be measured and stored in memory.

Motion 2

In the second returning motion we will sample ten full sine wave from the reference channels (there should be 30 measurements in one cycle, therefore we take 300 measurements)

then we sample the sine wave taking only two periods (30 points per period ), in the following conditions :

4 gain factors for fotodiode = 240 measur. 4 laser diode power values (out of 256 possible) = 240 measur. 4 values of the power read directly on the laser. 244 measur.

#### 6.2 - SYNTHETIC INTERFEROGRAM MODE

In this test we ask module O to transmit syntetic interferograms. The same telecommand is used to activate or disactivate this way of working. This is used also in test 2 ( see below).

#### 6.3 - SINE WAVE MODE

In this text , by giving a command to Module O we perform the sampling of the sine wave which is the interferogram of the laser diode . This tells us about the quality of the signal of the laser diode , and therefore if the motion is good or bad. The sine wavemay be modulated at short or long period , the modulation can be due to the fact that the laser light is not monochromatic . The temperature of the laser light may be the cause of the malfunctioning.

# 14. CHANGE DEFAULT CONTROL TABLE

THIS PROCEDURE CONTROLS MANY IMPORTANT PARAMETERS LIKE:

#### **TEMPERATURES**

PHOTODIODE GAIN

AND MANY OTHERS.

#### **OBDM** Control Table

The OBDM Control Table defines the most important parameters for the interferometer. Every parameter is represented by an hexadecimal value (size 8 Bits) which represents a real value. The short meaning of each parameter is shown on Table 1 and the relative coefficients are shown on Table 2, where you can also find the default values. In order to have the right value, one should multiply the value by the Scale Factor and after that summing the Offset. Any way someone of them are not linear, in this case is also represented the equation being used.

#### - T1,T8

High thermal gradients on the monoblock (the holder for the beamsplitters) can be in principle not a good start point to begin a measure, so we should reduce them. T1,T8 define the set points of the 8 individuals Temperature controllers.

Normally, in the real condition, they should be kept at 13° C.

#### - Laser 1 Power

This parameter defines the power set point for the Short Wavelength Laser Diode. Even if the power can be changed from 0 up to 4.97 mW, normally there is an ideal value (depending on the working Temperature and on the single device) which reduces at the minimum level, the low frequency modulation due to the side lobs. The narrower emission line the better reference signal.

#### - Laser 2 Power

The same of Laser 1 Power but for Long Wavelength.





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# - Laser 1 Temp.

It defines the Temperature set point for the Short Wavelength Temperature controller.

This should be set at least  $1.5^{\circ}$  C over the average Temperature of IB for having a good stability. In our case it is set at  $15^{\circ}$  C.

This parameter is crucial for the good working of Module-O. The Temperature of Laser, more than the power, determines the presence of the side lobs and it can make them become so strong that the speed controller could fail (in this extreme case Module-O is not capable to measure at all!). In case of this very bad condition we can of course use the other reference channel, the one not used at the moment.

Temperature of Laser is also important for the spectral calibration, because the emission line wavelength changes versus Temperature for approximately 0.4 nm per 1K.

## - Laser 2 Temp.

The same of Laser 1 (SW) Temperature but for Long Wavelength.

#### - TSW

This parameter defines the set point Temperature for the Short Wavelength detector controller and should be set between 200 K and 250 K depending on the condition. This one is important for the calibration as the detector changes the responsivity along its Temperature. Keep in mind that clearly the Temperature controlling is done at the case level. Please look at figure 1 in order to see where this controlling is placed.

#### - TLW

This parameter defines the set point Temperature for the Long Wavelength detector controller. Also in this case the Temperature controlling is done at the case level. Look at figure 1 to understand where it is placed.

#### - TRW 1

This parameter defines the current supplied to the Zero Optical Path Difference Detector for Short Wavelength. It should not be changed except when the Zero Optical Path Difference position is not centred with respect the SW interferogram.

#### - TRW 2

The same of TRW 1 but for LW.



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## - TIM20\_per

This parameter defines the period of the highest cutoff frequency for the SW Zero Crossing Preamplifier Filter (8th order). The lowest cutoff frequency is fixed (500 Hz, 2nd order) and unalterable. This value should be at least twice the reference frequency in order to maintain the speed control loop within the settling time value. This is of course true only for the reference signal used for such purpose.

### - TIM21\_per

The same of TIM20\_per but for the LW Zero Crossing Preamplifier Filter.

## - TIM22\_per

This parameter set the reference frequency for the speed control loop (normally 2000 Hz). Thus this value set the speed of the double pendulum and consequently also the medium sampling frequency of the reference channel used for controlling the speed.

# - TIM30\_per

This parameter defines the frequency used for the serial to parallel converter for the ADCs. In the normal conditions it should not be touched.

### - TIM31\_per

This parameter defines the period of the highest cutoff frequency for the SW Detector Preamplifier Filter (8th order). The lowest one is fixed (500 Hz, 2nd order). It should be set at 2 kHz but for the quantization error it is set at 2.2 kHz. This filter is an antialiasing filter for the SW ADCs, so it should be changed according to the speed of the double pendulum. Along the lowest cutoff frequency it also limits the bandpass of signal and noise and consequently the spectral range, too.

#### TIM32\_per

This parameter defines the period of the highest cutoff frequency for the LW Detector Preamplifier Filter (8th order). The lowest one is fixed (50 Hz, 2nd order). It should be set at 500 Hz but for the quantization error it is set at 513 Hz. This filter is an antialiasing filter for the LW ADCs, so it should be changed according to the speed of the double pendulum. Along the lowest cutoff frequency it also limits the bandpass of signal and noise and consequently the spectral range, too.

## - MskALFA A

- xxxxxA1A0 These 2 bits together with the bit a6 of the maskbeta a define the gain for the SW Detector Amplifier. Gain increases by a factor 2 per step. In principle each gain should be calibrated. There are in total 8 possible gains . The most significant bit is in a6 maskbeta.
- xxxxA3A2xx These 2 bits define the gain for the LW Detector Amplifier. Gain increases by a factor 2 per step. In principle each gain should be calibrated.





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- xxxA4xxxx This bit turns on the ADC 1a. "1" stands for SW reference channel, "a" stands for primary ADC. The primary ADC input is connected to the relative reference channel (now SW). When this bit is set to 1, we'll have the SW interferogram sampled by SW reference channel. Normal condition requires this bit set to 1.
- xxA5xxxxx This bit turns on the ADC 1b. "1" stands for SW reference channel, "b" stands for secondary ADC. The secondary ADC input is connected to the opposite reference channel. When this bit is set to 1, we'll have the LW interferogram sampled by SW reference channel. Normal condition requires this bit set to 0. The using of this condition changes the spectral behaviour of the LW channel, since the reference channel does not belong to the same channel and the length of the double pendulum brackets is not equal for the two channels. Thus this bit should be set only in case of failure of the LW reference channel.
- xA6xxxxx This bit turns on the ADC 2a. "2" stands for LW reference channel, "a" stands for primary ADC. The primary ADC input is connected to the relative reference channel (now LW). When this bit is set to 1, we'll have the LW interferogram sampled by LW reference channel. Normal condition requires this bit set to 1.
- A7xxxxxxx This bit turns on the ADC 2b. "2" stands for LW reference channel, "b" stands for secondary ADC. The secondary ADC input is connected to the opposite reference channel (now SW). When this bit is set to 1, we'll have the SW interferogram sampled by LW reference channel. Normal condition requires this bit set to 0. The using of this condition changes the spectral behaviour of the SW channel, since the reference channel does not belong to the same channel and the length of the double pendulum brackets is not equal for the two channels. Thus this bit should be set only in case of failure of the SW reference channel.

#### - MskBETA A

- xxxxxxxA0 This bit selects the double pendulum motor being used. In case of motor or driver failure one can select the working one ( if any! ). By default is set the primary one.
- xxxxxA1x This bit selects the double pendulum direction for doing the motion. Normally the motion driving is automatically set by OBDM. Much care should be taken in order to use this bit. The using of it is not recommended.
- xxxxA3A2xx When these two bits are set to 1 (both) the double pendulum is on a reset state. By default they are set to 1 but during the acquisition OBDM sets them in the right way automatically.
- xxA4A5xxxx The setting of this two bits does not affect the blocking or unblocking procedure of the double pendulum.
  - A6 is the most significant bit for the gain of the SW detector.
  - -A7 SW filter switch: 0 is normal (default) value, 1 is attenuated in the thermal part.

#### - MskBETA B

- xxxxxxB1B0 These two bits set the gain of the SW Zero Crossing Amplifier. The step is a factor 2.
- xxxxB3B2xx These two bits set the gain of the LW Zero Crossing Amplifier. The step is a factor 2.
- xxxB4xxxx This bit selects the reference channel signal to be used as reference for the speed control loop. The default is 0 which means SW reference channel. In case of failure of this channel one can use the LW reference channel. Keep in mind that the using of the LW reference channel like a speed control reference can a little affect the speed of





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the double pendulum and the sampling frequency of the two channels. Thus also the highest part of the spectrum can also be a little affected.

- xxB5xxxxx This bit, when reset, turns on the SW Laser Diode. By default it is switched off.
- xB6xxxxxx This bit, when reset, turns on the LW Laser Diode. By default it is switched off.
- B7 is a single bit that allows to switch the TRW counting from the SW channel ( =0 ) , to the LW channel (=1) .



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#### 18 SET ICM MODE

Some Data Telemetry modes require the use of the ICM module ( FFT module ) . This module must be set to work , as it requires some information before starting. ICM can perform sine-cos transform , power spectra transform, interferogram compression transform . The sin-cos transform is inheritage from the past and is not used any more.

The power spectra transform can be done with or without apodization (1 bit).

The power spectra can be done with or without subtracting the average value (1 bit).

Two bits are required to define the way the ICM will do the FFT and the memory used ( see paragraph 2.3.3 ) .

- 7 bits are required to give the fine tuning of the base level for the data compression, which is 7F00 in exadecimal + the value given multiplied by 2. In this way the wings of the interferograms can be transmitted in bytes instead of words.
